

## BRILLIANCE NEUTRAL CLEANER

### Description

BRILLIANCE NEUTRAL CLEANER is a cleaning agent to be added to water for damp wiping of finished and oiled hard-wood flooring. It is also suitable for other floors, doors, window frames and plastic surfaces. The product is available as a concentrate.

### Note

Please note that a finished floor does not only require cleaning but also a maintenance product from time to time. For finished hardwood floors we recommend our care product BRILLIANCE EVERCLEAR.

For basic cleaning of finished floors, we recommend BRILLIANCE CLEANER L94.

Always keep cleaning agents out of reach of children!

### Application

For regular maintenance:  
Remove dirt using a broom or vacuum cleaner. Damp wipe the floor. Carefully remove sticky dirt with a white pad.

BRILLIANCE NEUTRAL CLEANER can also be used in conjunction with the BERGERTOOL SPRAYMOP COMFORTCLEAN.

The concentrate can be mixed at a mixing ratio of 1:200, i.e. 50 ml of concentrate are diluted in 10 l of water, a dilution of 1:100 is recommended – 100 ml concentrate to 10 l of water.

### Drying

After drying the floor is ready for use.

### Storage / transport

Shelf life of original unopened packing 36 months min. provided that material is transported and stored at a cool and dry place.
